

# Highway 403

## - Hwy 401 to QEW

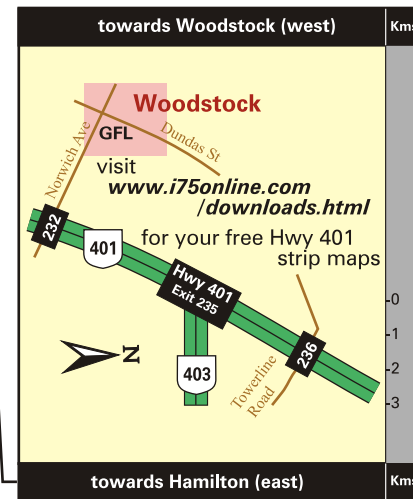
Highway 403 was originally opened to provide a freeway connection between the 401 (near Woodstock) to the Queen Elizabeth Way and communities southwest of Lake Ontario. It is primarily a route through rural countryside with little in the way of exit services except at the few towns along the way. There are no rest areas.

Sideroads paralleling the highway have been included (in brown) to provide "escape routes" should the highway traffic become heavy.
