**Time to drive** between exits 128 & 122:  
 - via I-75 6 mins.  
 - via Norris Dam 18 mins.

Tennessee - S/Bound: exit 128  
 - N/Bound: exit 122

A scenic alternative route to the I-75. Runs across the Norris Dam and through winding riverside roads, past the Museum of the Appalachia (well worth a visit) before rejoining the I-75 at exit 122. Caution - a great drive on a good day but do not use in bad weather.
